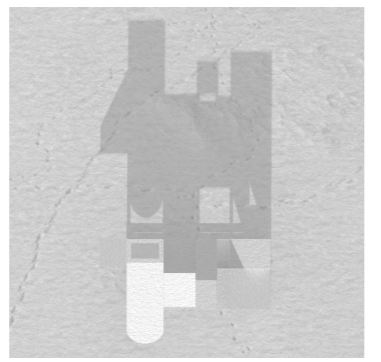
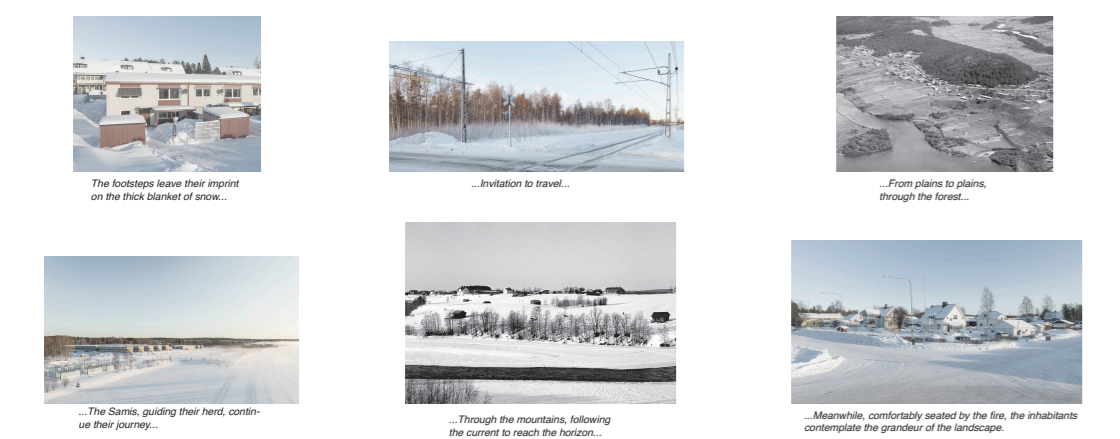

Along the river, several recreational facilities emerged along its banks. Shaded picnic areas, winding walking paths, and viewpoints offer visitors unique experiences...

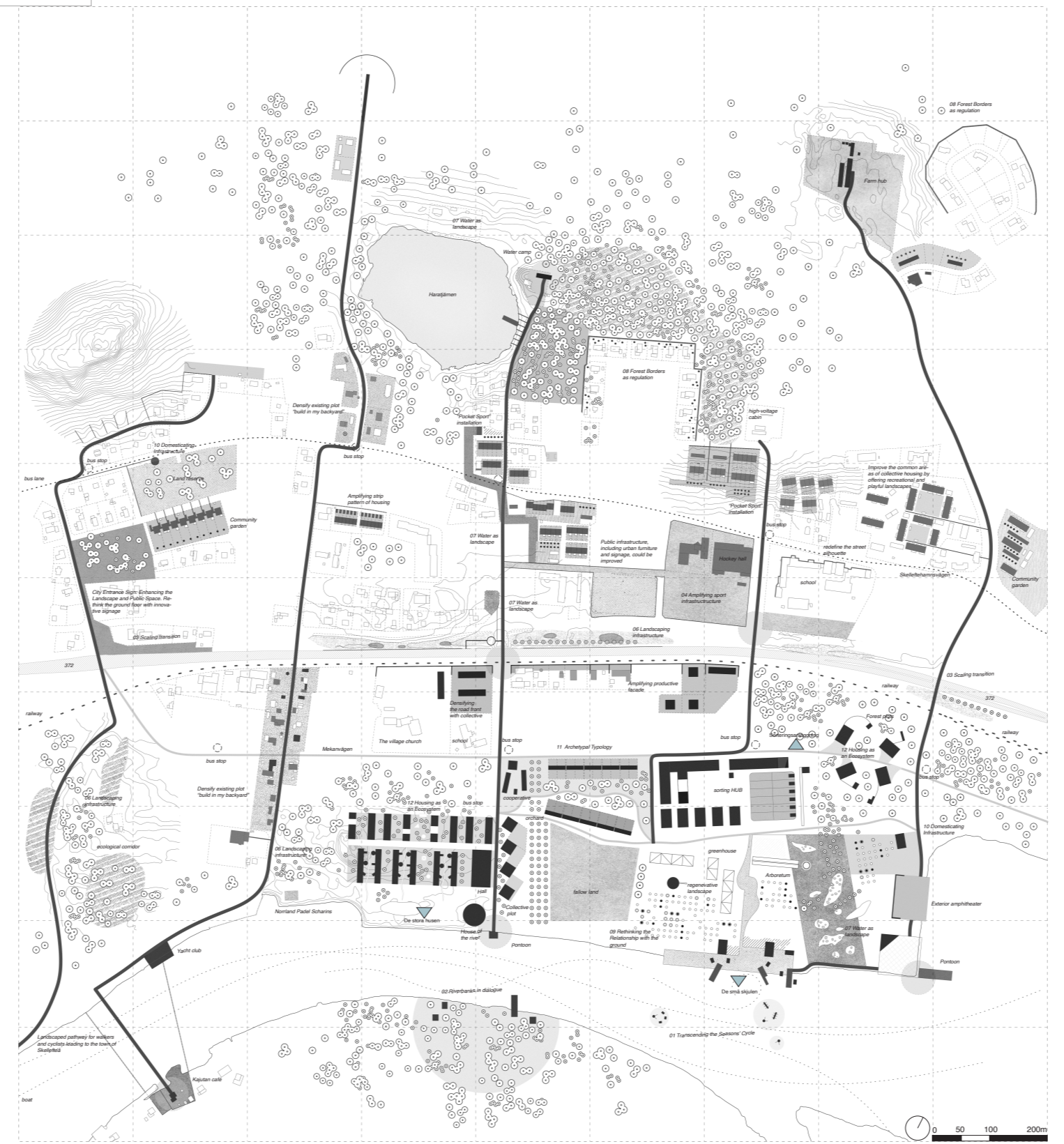

The city is a "string of pearls" morphology of major cities from Skellefteå, east through the country. From this main axis, secondary corridors extend to serve smaller localities...

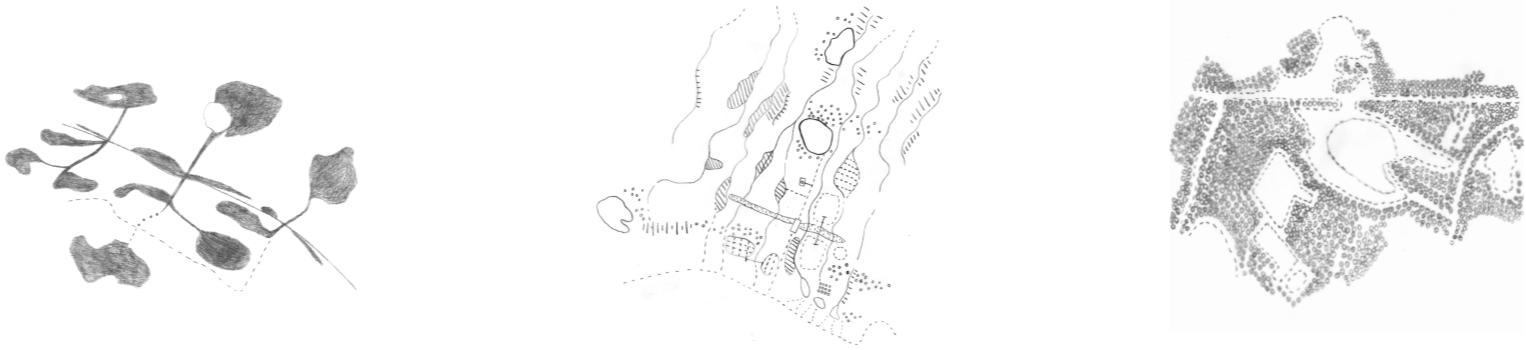

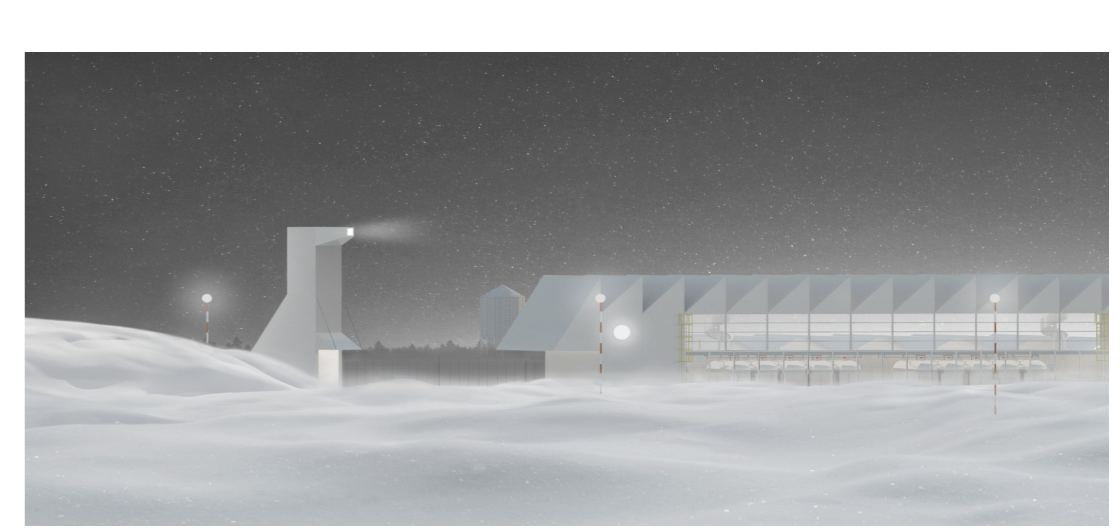
