



MIT glazed sections aligned to the 6+6 metre structural grid. 
Entrances, smaller shops and public-facing functions activate 
the new urban corridor, while larger retail units are positioned 
deeper inside. 
Above, a terraced housing addition in a lightweight timber and 
steel frame extends the structure while minimising load on 
the existing building. The roof is equipped with solar panels, 
and the expansive rooftop becomes a green landscape with 
community gardens for residents and allotments. 
The transformation preserves the logic of the original building 
while giving Gotstunale Centrum a renewed presence, 
more open, vibrant and connected to its surroundings.
