### **European 9**

1- Karen Stub Christensen - Kristine Holter-Andersen - Signe Høyer Frederiksen - Christine Vad Majgaard. Herning, Winners. Contract signed with the team.

2- Vejle. No prize-winner found. The municipality, developed, however, a new project for the site with approx 8 of the teams who submitted proposals, on an open web platform.

### **European 10**

1- Morten Vedelsbøl - Scott Grbavac. Augustenborg, Winners. The team works on qualifying the project which will make the foundation for the enactment of the local plan.

2- Mari-Liis Männik - Johanne Heesche. Rudkøbing, Winners. The team participates in the work of a larger analysis of Rudkøbing which takes its starting point in the winning project. The team has worked on a smaller area adjacent to the project area.

3- Tanja Jordan - Kristoffer Nejsum - Sanne Lovén Damgaard. København, Winners. The project is part of the master plan for the whole of the Nordhavnen area. It is the expectation that the team will go into cooperation with the advisory team of Nordhavnen in the first half of 2011 in order to implement the winning project.

4- Stine Christiansen - Luise Lorenc - Stine Christiansen. Kolding, Winners. An overall plan for the project area has been politically approved and a steering group has been appointed in order to make way for the next phase. First step is to work out a local plan which takes its starting point in an adapted version of the winning project. A local plan is expected to be approved in the beginning of 2012.
