### **Europän 13, site visit 2015-03-17**

Question: What is the municipality's standpoint  
regarding the allotment gardens?

Answer: The destiny of the allotment garden is  
obviously pivotal for the competition. The argument  
against them is that it is not a very efficient use of land  
in a denser city. The argument to keep them, is that it is  
considered a very "positive" activity.

Other municipalities have relocated them to other parts  
of the city with less "building pressure".

The whole question is also politically sensitive.

Therefore, what to do with the allotment gardens is a  
important part of the competition and still an open  
question.

Question: Is the location of the new rail way station  
decided?

Answer: The final position is still not decided; however  
the precise position is regarded to be of less importance  
for the competition.

It is possible to move the station in relation to the  
proposed one in the competition brief, given that it can  
be argued for.
