

We walked around the Anttila area and visited first the old warehouses (no 7) and the historical barn (no 1). From there we continued to the shore and walked along the boat berths. We returned by the residential buildings and visited the Rannakoukku house (no 3). At the end of the visit we had a chance to take a look inside the Activity center Kettunen (no 2).

After visiting Anttila we continued to the 2020 Housing Fair site in Rykmentinpuisto and had a presentation about wood frame houses by achitect Pekka Saatsi.

Q: How should we take the Natura area into consideration?

A: Natura in Tuusula is a nature preserve area with rich bird life. The rare species in the area and their natural habitats are protected by law and must not be disturbed or destroyed. No permanent construction should be proposed for the Natura area. However, lighter or temporary structures that will not disturb the birdlife, such as duckboards, can be proposed.
