### LEGAL PROVISIONS FOR FOREIGN ARCHITECTS

In Sweden the title "architect" is not protected, nor is the profession. Anyone can apply for a building permit. There are no legal restrictions to foreign architects

exercising their profession in Sweden or having their projects implemented. It is however common that foreign architects in this situation for practical reasons collaborate with a Swedish architect.

In European, the competition rules stipulate that each team must include an architect. For the Swedish competition sites, this is defined as someone who has a university degree in architecture (with a masters level or equivalent) or is a member in a professional architectural organisation affiliated to UIA or ACE. The team must be able to show documents to support this on request.
