Advertisement for EUROSPAN 17 in the official publication is made through the State Procurement Platform (<https://contrataciondelestado.es>), B.O.E. (State Official Journal) and the Regional official publications to which the sites belong.

Information to all the architects through the 19 local Orders of architects and through the Consejo Superior de los Colegios de Arquitectos de España Web

An advertisement is published in a national newspaper some weeks before the registration deadline.

The aim of EUROSPAN Spain is to implement the projects chosen by EUROSPAN 17 national jury.

In order to facilitate contracting of the proposals by public administrations participating in EUROSPAN Spain as the core of the competition, the Ministry of Transports, Mobility and Urban Agenda launches the Competition in Spain, establishing its Rules by a bidding document that shall comply with the procedure of Juried Design Competitions as provided in section 183 et seq of the LCSP, and publishing the competition in the State Procurement Platform (<https://contrataciondelestado.es>). This will ensure compliance with the conditions established in the EUROSPAN Internal Procedures and in the aforementioned Law.

Therefore, in case of entering any of the Spanish sites, it is important to get familiar with the “Rules of the EUROSPAN 17 Juried Design Competition”.

#### **LEGAL PROVISIONS FOR FOREIGN ARCHITECTS**

Nationals from EU and EES countries in possession of a diploma in accordance with Directive 2005/36/EC and wishing to practice the profession on a temporary or occasional basis must be legally established in a Member State for the purpose of pursuing the same profession in Spain. They shall submit a written declaration to the competent authority, the Ministry of Transports, Mobility and Urban (Ministerio de Transportes, Movilidad y Agenda Urbana, Subdirección de Normativa y Estudios Técnicos. Secretaría General Técnica. Paseo de la Castellana, 67 – 28071 Madrid). This declaration has to be made by winning teams previous to the implementation process.
