Legal Provisions for Foreign Architects

European union's principle on the free movement of persons implies that member states' citizens' can work in other member states, as well as in Norway,



Iceland and Lichtenstein and in certain cases Switzerland, without having to obtain a working permit.

Following the reciprocity principle, citizens of the member states that stipulate limited employment rights for Croatian citizens in the interim period can't get employment in Croatia without a special permit.

European 5

Vukovar - Implementation procedure was begun, the winning team signed the contract, but the project remains unbuilt.

European 7

Rijeka - Implementation by the winning project in form of the Detailed Plan, still in procedure.

European 8

Zagreb - This implementation started in 2011. And the winning design was adapted to the needs of the developers. The project hasn't reached the construction phase.

After the competition, the winning team were in contact with the city government; a workshop was organized to analyze the entries and the programme. No activity took place after that.

European 13

The City of Zagreb has organized a workshop with the winning teams and jury members, outlining the upcoming steps in the implementation process. The City has invited the winning team to adapt the winning entry and the physical implementation followed in 2019 as "Summer on Sava River". Due to COVID it didn't happen again, but similar festivals were organized in the following years.

Nin - After the exhibition and public presentation of the winning and runner-up entry, the City of Nin didn't go into further implementation procedure.

Karlovac - In the European 15 Karlovac site the first prize went to a team of architects from Zagreb: Hana Dašić, Iva Erić, Jana Horvat, Ria Tursan, Krešimir Renić and Andrea Majić.

In July 2020, at the proposal of European Croatia, the Advisory Board for creation of the UPU Luščić-centar was established, with members from European, the City of Karlovac and the Jury. The Advisory board met for 8 times and conducted consultation with the public.

The procedure ensured that the „Luščić-centar“ plan was adopted in February of 2022 by the City Council of the City of Karlovac, in a transparent manner and respecting all relevant stakeholders. The plan is the result of the European 15 competition and the work of the Advisory Board.

Commissions for school and daycare are in procedure (March 2023)
