LA LOUVIÈRE – Tim Denninger, Tomoyuki Haramura & Patrick Longchamps, Winner. First phase of the project. Three more phases waiting.

Europan 6

CHÂTELET – Ruddy Picard, Sébastien Causin, Bertrand Noël & Vincent Virgo, Winner. Participation of the team to the stage of the project’s administrative preparation. Participation of Rudy Picard in some projects of the social Housing Society. The winning team is involved in an urban project on the Châtelet site.

MONS-GHLIN – Jean-Philippe De Visscher, Christophe Lootvoet & Amélie Paris, Winner. Constructive presentation to the local authorities. Urban planning first.

Europan 9

1- LOUVAIN LA NEUVE – Christophe Lootvoet, Winner. Favourably received by the local authorities. The Winner made contacts with a view to developing the site with local services.
2- ANDENNE – Boris Bouchet, Jérôme Lafond, Thomas Nouailler & Yvan Okotnikoff, Winner. Several meetings and exchanges of view have been held with the local administration and the Cabinet for Town and Country Planning. The town should decide on which procedure to follow to create optimum conditions to achieve the whole project. The town has recently purchased a plot of land essential for the implementation of the project.

Europan 10

GEMBLoux – Alberto Mottola, Simone Gobbo & Davide De Marchi. Gembloux, Winner. The winning project culminated in a fine achievement in keeping with the essence and aesthetics of the chosen theme. The building was inaugurated in September 2015. The project team nominated for this same site (Rénald Pansaerts, Ronald Riffart & Joël Meersseman) was assigned, as a sub-contractor to the Italian team, the mission of architect for the operation.

Europan 11

- 1- **MARCHE-EN-FAMENNE** – Anca Diana Popescu & Sorin Vladimir Popescu, Winner. A number of contacts and meetings took place with the city authorities immediately after the competition. Acquisition of private properties is underway in order to clear the project zone. The mayor, re-elected in October 2018, informed us that he would do everything possible to finalize the project despite the administrative difficulties related to the administrative situation of the site which does not promote the rapid progress of the project.
- 2- **SAMBREVILLE** – Danilo Capasso, Bruna Vendemmia, Laura Falcone, Anna Sirica, Giovanni Aurino & Carmine Ciuccio, Runner-up. Benoît Coulondres & Florence Gaudin, Runner-up. A workshop was organised involving the 2 teams mentioned – The Italian team's project was chosen by the city authorities and incorporated into the Mayor's legislative plan. The team is in the process of administrative finalization of the conclusion of the contract with the city for a complementary study mission.

Europan 12

SERAING – Luis Masia Massoni & Fabio Cavaterra, Winner. The two contracting parties (Société Provinciale d'Industrialisation and Arcelor MITTAL) support the winning project, as do the political authorities of the City of Seraing. Alongside the public operator, we presented the project at MIPIM 2013 in order to obtain more financial backing. The project has been delayed due to clearance and depollution of the industrial site.

Europan 13

- 1- **CHARLEROI** – Radim Louda, Paul Mouchet, Pierre Burquel, Valentin Piret & Tina Javornik, Runner-up. Yajun Chen & Gaofei Tan, Runner-up. A press conference was held in May 2016 to present both runner-up projects, as well as the 2 special mention projects. The four teams participated in a workshop at the end of which a team was appointed (team of Radim Louda, Paul Mouchet, Pierre Burquel, Valentin Piret & Tina Javornik). The team was commissioned to work on public spaces and sports equipment. The study phase has been validated and the building permit for the public spaces and a boxing pavilion has been obtained. The project is under construction.
- 2- **LIBRAMONT** – No winner or runner-up project was retained for this site. However, the city seems interested by one of the projects shortlisted in the initial phases and is considering it in the reworking of the masterplan.

Europan 14

- 1- **TUBIZE** – Humberto Miguel Aguiar Pereira, Winner. Simone Valerio, Frederik Vandyck, Pauline Durand, Stijn Elsen, Tom Uytendaele, Mentioned team. The city and the private property developer (Duferco) organized a workshop with the 2 teams put forward by the jury. The choice of the winner was confirmed after 2 days of work. He received a first two-phase contract which began in December 2018 for a cultural centre and a library project (public part) and a welfare centre (private part). Tubize is currently looking for budgets for the realization of the project.

- 2- **HUY** – Fabrice Rossi, Elisa Baldin, runner-up. The city plans to organize a workshop with the 4 teams selected by the jury (runner-up team, and the 3 teams having received a special mention).

European 15

- 1- **CHARLEROI** – The jury could not decide for a winner and a runner-up.

A mission contract was in discussion between the architects and the social housings society but didn't finally succeed because of shorten loan.
