Practice of the profession for foreign architects

Law No. 77-2 of January 3, 1977 on architecture

Article 9

Amended by Order No. 2005-1044 of August 26, 2005 - art. 2 JORF August 27, 2005

Natural persons registered on a regional register of architects in accordance with the provisions of Articles 10 and 11 may only bear the title of architect

Legal persons registered on a regional register of architects in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 below may only bear the title of architectural firm. Registration on a regional register or its annex confers the right to practice throughout the national territory.

Article 10

Amended by LAW No. 2011-302 of March 22, 2011 - art. 13

On request, individuals of French nationality or nationals of a Member State of the European Community or another State party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area who enjoy their civil rights, provide the necessary guarantees of morality and meet one of the following conditions are registered on a regional register of architects:

1° Either hold the State diploma of architect or another French diploma of architect recognized by the State, and hold the authorization of the State-certified architect to exercise project management in his own name issued by the State, or hold a diploma, certificate or other foreign title allowing the exercise of the profession of architect and recognized by the State;

2° Hold a diploma, certificate or other qualification issued by a third State, which has been recognised in a Member State or in another State party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area and which has allowed them to legally exercise the profession

in that State for a minimum period of three years, provided that this professional experience is certified by the State in which it was acquired;

When the minimum period of three years has not been completed in the State which recognised the said diploma, certificate or qualification, the holder must be recognised as qualified by the Minister responsible for culture in view of the knowledge and qualifications attested by this diploma, certificate or qualification and by all the training and professional experience acquired;

3° Be recognized as qualified by the Minister responsible for culture, after examination of all the relevant knowledge, qualifications and professional experience in light of those required by the rules in force for access to the exercise of this profession, when the applicant does not have the diplomas, certificates and other qualifications listed in Annexes V, point 5.7, and VI of Directive 2005 / 36 / EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 September 2005 on the recognition of professional qualifications. In the cases mentioned in 2° and 3°, the Minister responsible for culture may require, for the registration of the person concerned on the register of the order, the completion of a compensation measure;

4° Be recognized as qualified by the Minister responsible for culture upon presentation of professional references establishing that the person has particularly distinguished himself by the quality of his achievements in the field of architecture after the opinion of a national commission.

The terms of application of 2°, 3° and 4° are set by a decree in the Council of State.

Article 10- 1

Amended by LAW No. 2011-302 of March 22, 2011 - art. 13

An architect who is a national of a Member State of the European Community or another State party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area and who is legally established in one of these States may practice the profession of architect in France on a temporary and occasional basis without being registered on a regional register of architects.

The architect providing services is subject to the rules and procedures relating to the conditions of practice of the profession, the use of the professional title, the professional or ethical and disciplinary rules applicable to the profession, as well as the insurance obligations corresponding to the services envisaged.

The performance of these services is subject to a prior written declaration to the regional council of the order of architects during the first service. This declaration is renewed once a year if the service provider plans to carry out his professional activity occasionally during the year concerned or in the event of a material change in his situation. It is accompanied in particular by information relating to insurance coverage and other means of personal or collective protection.

In the event that the service provider does not benefit from automatic recognition of diplomas, the regional council of the order of architects will verify the declared professional qualifications. Following this verification, and in the event of a substantial difference between the professional qualifications of a service provider and the training required in France, the regional council of the order of architects proposes to the service provider to submit to an aptitude test in order to demonstrate that he has acquired the missing knowledge and skills before a committee sitting at the National Council of the Order of Architects whose composition is set by decree.

A decree in the Council of State specifies the conditions of application of this article.

Article 11

Created by law 77-2 1977-01-03 JORF of January 4, 1977 rectifying JORF January 5 and 21, 1977

Natural persons who are nationals of States not members of the European Economic Community are registered, upon their request, on a regional register under the same conditions of diploma, certificate, title of architecture or qualification, enjoyment of civil rights and morality as the French, if they can rely on reciprocity agreements or international commitments. If this last condition is not met, they may nevertheless be authorized to practice the profession of architect, according to a procedure set by decree. The same decree specifies the conditions under which a foreign architect may, without being registered on a regional register, be authorized to carry out a specific project in France.

For all candidates who are nationals of member states of the European Community or another third state, must imperatively refer to the articles above and to the following decree and order:

Decree No. 2009-1490 of December 2, 2009 relating to the recognition of professional qualifications for the practice of the profession of architect

Order of December 17, 2009 relating to the procedures for recognizing professional qualifications for the practice of the profession of architect, (to read on www.legifrance.gouv.fr)

The architect may practice individually in a liberal form or within the framework of an architectural firm (article 14 of the aforementioned law)

Processes

The competition follow-ups are launched by the GIP EPAU in collaboration with Europan France in the continuity of the national jury and as soon as the results are announced. A follow-up expert is commissioned, after those of the site and project, to assist the city and the teams in setting up an order as close as possible to the results of the competition. Beforehand, in the three months following the announcement of the results, the GIP EPAU in collaboration with Europan France, organizes official national exchange meetings and on-site workshops to present the projects to the sponsors (Meetings of Cities, Territories & Teams). These moments initiate local work conducive to the operational handover to the cities. The PUCA can be requested to subsidize certain processes of the Europan follow-ups.

Experimentation article of the public procurement code

Public Procurement Code

Article R2172 33 & 34

Creation Decree No. 2018-1075 of December 3, 2018

For the construction of works resulting from projects selected by the State as part of a national public research, testing and experimentation program, the buyer may enter into contracts for project management or works, on some of these works in order to verify their relevance.

These contracts are concluded at the end of a competitive tendering procedure in accordance with the provisions of this book, limited to economic operators chosen from among those whose projects will have been selected by the jury of the national public program, after publication of a contract notice.

An experimentation protocol is entered into between the buyer and the public body responsible for the national program.

Europan 17: 2024

1- Bernay/Brionne, Terres de Normandie "A multi-site territorial project for the Risle valleys": Presentations of the 3 selected projects were made by the teams on site, in particular on April 21, 2024, to local stakeholders (P Bouilhol, C. Pastier, M. Lecomte, J. Beaute, L. Cisse, J.-V. Boucher / B. Wullschleger, P. Benoit / P. de C., M. Rabie, N. Jain). A specification for launching an experimental laboratory was sent on February 13, 2025 for the carrying out of studies on the articulation of mutable sites and prefiguration actions before the end of 2025. Other operational missions could be initiated with private partners thereafter. The allocation of the expertise of the follow-ups was unsuccessful, it is being relaunched for March 2025.

2- Courcy-Grand Reims "A process project for an abandoned airbase": "In-situ" visits and workshops took place in the presence of elected officials, representatives of the SCIC, the three selected teams (K. Lahiani, A. Barthélémy, M. Bardou / M. Vandebussche, O. Chenevier / R. Joly, A. Cecchini). The teams revised their projects, in order to make them more operational and propose initial concrete avenues on June 7, 2024. The project management team around Microville 112 gave its agreement for the continuation of Europan support through the expertise provided by Jeanne Gerbeaud. A new

programming workshop is being organized for the summer of 2025 with a view to drafting specifications to define the work to be assigned to the 3 teams.

3- Fleurance "An operational commitment for urban renewal": An exhibition of all the submissions from January 2024 and several discussion workshops with the selected teams (M. Fayollas, R. Schwab, J. Ahumada, A. Renaudineau, P. Cegiely / N. Pinard, F. Roudier-Canler, P.-A. Pernot, M. Viaud, V. Dussap, C.-S. Olivetti / E. Vogel, D. Truong, E. Froelich) were organized by the city of Fleurance, thanks to the assistance of the expert, Hugo Franck. A mission to further develop the projects on the "store block" was assigned to the 3 selected teams. The objective is to launch a project management operation for the reconversion of this part of the wasteland into a home for young workers and a house of associations. Following the teams' submission on October 22, 2024, a consultation restricted to the 3 teams selected for the realization of this 1st phase of programming should be launched in early 2025 with the support of a PUCA grant.

4- Grenoble-Alpes Métropole "Le Parc des Boucles de l'Isère": Following a presentation of the projects by all the candidates (I. Chervet, A. Bech, L. Lepesteur / S. Doublet, F. Bessoud-Cavillot, M. Goutelle, A. Perrocheau, L. Valladier, E. Mouchel / T. Faucheux, T. Tronville, A. Riegert, L.-M. Dubiez) to elected officials and local stakeholders, two teams were selected: the special mention team, "(s)lowland" for the rehabilitation of a barn of the GAM agricultural project and the feasibility study of the rehabilitation of another barn. And the winning team "Sols Mobiles" for a project management contract for a guide plan, an operational development project in the central Vizille area. A workshop to kick off the follow-up is planned for this first quarter of 2025 according to specifications currently being validated and monitored by the expertise of Malaury Forget.

5- Guérande "A sensitive approach to a fortified city and a saline landscape": A mission to prefigure public spaces was awarded to the winning team "Terraqué" (Noël Picaper and Mylène Lach, architects). The mission started in September 2024 but unfortunately, it was suspended due to a lack of funding. The follow-up is no longer defined despite careful expertise provided by Armelle Goyon.

6- Le Palais/Belle-Ile-en-Mer "Multi-thematic strategy for living well on an island": A meeting to present the three projects (G. Milà, C. Berger, J. Maillard, E. Métivier, E. Adda / Y. Houllard, M. Gate, F. Picourla / L. E. Chanteau, I. Lacoudre, M. Boisset, G. Lachat) took place in the presence of the selected teams and local elected officials who confirmed their desire to continue developing the European operational suites in their territory. Following a request from the DDTM 56 this summer, the Mayor of Le Palais specified by letter on November 20, 2024, his expectations on two scales: architectural on the quays and territorial on marine submersion. In connection with the expertise assigned to Thomas Nouailler, a mission proposal letter was sent to the project owner on January 20, 2025.

7- Marseille "The natural challenges of a changing mobility infrastructure": The metropolis launched into transdisciplinary workshops of artists and architects on October 7 and November 25, 2024, with the three selected teams (I. L. Amo, J. Nassif, A. Bertrand / J.-B. Clot, M. Stuckelberger / C. Vermeulen, J. Vincent, M. Morize, A. Parcheta, M.-A. Meyer, L. Peneau, T. Carcano) hosted by the national cultural scene "Lieux Publics", also crossed by the Aygalades. An innovative market allocation is currently being drafted in partnership with the SNCF, owner of the abandoned railway network, with the idea of purchasing a work of art and spirit that could take the form of a video production.

8- Nantes "When food resilience questions the future of the Hôtel-Dieu": Project presentation workshops were held with local stakeholders and the three selected teams (T. Barbier, P. Riffault, T. Catti, J.-B. Boccaren, A. Benoit / M. Lucas, Á. Aguilera Delgao,

Louis Cayol. An exhibition of all the projects submitted took place from mid-September to the end of October 2024 at the Nantes School of Architecture, as well as a round table with renowned guests on "citizen inspirations", led by the follow-up expert, Julia Tournaire. Support missions for the organization of this exhibition and the follow-up to the consultation were entrusted to the 3 teams. One of the teams, special mention for the "Loire Food Pact" formed into the "Collectif Têtes-Bêches" was selected in a grouping with "Le Sens de la Ville" to provide the AMO for the transformation of the Hôtel-Dieu with SAMOA. Other suites of architectural and heritage mediations are also envisaged.

9- Rennes "The challenges of a district marked by the departure of its University Hospital": A desire was expressed by the Rennes metropolis to promote the work carried out by the candidates through an exhibition of all the renderings which will take place from February 24 to March 7, 2025 and a round table on "hospital architecture" at ENSAB on March 4, 2025 in the presence of the three teams (R. Balay, F. Vaugoyeau / A. Vincent, J. Froger, M. Deniaud / R. Itard, J. Padioleau, L. Pinel, F. Morin). The expertise, followed by Emmanuel Redoutey, proposed in parallel the organization of a workshop with the three teams and the SEM Territoires, to carry out an architectural feasibility exercise and identification of priorities.

10- Métropole Rouen Normandie "An upstream territory and cordon between hillside and river": A consultation of the three selected teams (J. Hallaj, V. Beley, T. Finkel, I. Lalanne / S. Gonzalez Porqueres, A. Pont Aineto, D. Foz Figuerola, L. Batsi Aragon / C. Pierson, R. Molines) is planned for the year 2025 according to specifications supervised by the follow-up expert, Grégoire Deberdt, but without a provisional date for the moment.

Europen 16: 2022

1- Pont-Aven: The three selected teams were brought together for a 6-month mission including 3 on-site workshops and a consultation and restitution workshop. The teams will be consulted again for the pre-operational follow-ups carried out by the Brittany land establishment for the Belle Angèle wasteland reconversion project.

2- Auneuil: The three selected teams were brought together for a 6-month mission including 3 on-site workshops. The workshops began in September 2022 and ended with a restitution of the study on July 3, 2023. The teams also participated in the heritage days of September 2023. The follow-up expert, Jeanne Gerbeaud and the GIP EPAU noted a halt to the studies by the European teams since the city gave a mission to a design office from the ANCT markets.

3- Bassens: Also, the three selected teams were brought together for a 6-month mission including 3 on-site workshops and restitution, but still no follow-ups ordered.

4- Aulnat: The three teams each had a substantial mission, with common and specific objects. The Spanish team from Barcelona actively participated. And a PUCA grant was requested, it is in progress. Thanks to a new contact with the lessor Assemblia on December 18, 2024 and following an on-site visit by the GIP EPAU, a project management consultation on the Chapels will be relaunched quickly.

5- Niort Agglo: The three teams were consulted for the award of a framework agreement, with 3 identified lots corresponding to 3 project sites, awarded to different teams; "Vallée mutuelles" won the 2 studies / the "Port terrestre" team is working on the large business center on the Route de Paris. A report on the 3rd phase was presented on December 12, 2024 and a work, led by the follow-up expert, Emmanuel Redoutey, of cross-restitution on these demonstrator sites is planned for mid-2025 around the city entrance corridors. Also in progress, a grant application to the PUCA.

- 6- La Porte du Hainaut: A consultation was launched with the 3 teams for a project management mission on the design and implementation of the operation to develop public spaces at the Arenberg mining site, launched by the urban community. Two responses were formulated by all the teams selected for the competition: the first by the Rijsel studio. The second, by Vis à Vis architecture-urbanisme (manager) associated with Kollektif Landscape. On October 15, 2024, the study report was presented in the presence of the expert, Nicolas Binet. The follow-ups are moving towards operational.
- 7- Grenoble: The architecture residency was launched on February 8, 2024 in the Rabot university campus within the Bastille site, in the form of a contract awarded to the GRAB collective bringing together the three selected teams. With the expertise provided by Vincent Josso, the results were presented on January 10, 2025 to the strategic committee. The follow-ups financially supported by the PUCA will be deployed at the next Villes en Transition biennial on May 15, 2025.
- 8- Quimper: The three selected teams participated in various events to animate the site, but no follow-ups are planned for the moment.

European 15 :

- 1- Floirac: Urban studies have been delivered, with no concrete follow-ups for the moment.
- 2- Pays de Dreux: A consultation of the 3 teams on 3 sites was launched at the beginning of 2024. Two teams, those of Trung May and UR (PJU 2024) were selected and began their strategic studies on June 5, 2024. The 2nd phase of scenarios on the activity zones and an OAP were presented to elected officials during a COPIL on January 20, 2025. A valuation of this work, supervised by the expert Emmanuel Redoutey, is planned in the operational phase for the summer of 2025. Support from the PUCA has also been requested.
- 3- Port-Jérôme-sur-Seine: An urban study mission was entrusted to the aforementioned team (U. Nataloni, M. Forget, U. Panel, R. Prost)
- 4- Saint-Omer: The winner Iris Chervet was entrusted with a study on the city center after a call for tenders. 2024: the urban planning agency relaunches an intercommunal territory project based on water. The Mayor of Arques will launch a consultation for the 3 selected teams around a flood-prone park. In progress.
- 5- Marseille: On the occasion of European 17 concerning a neighboring sector, the follow-up will possibly be reconsidered. In progress.
- 6- Champigny: The EPA Marne entrusted the winner (G. Barnavon) with an urban study on the eastern service road to Paris.
- 7- Aubry: An urban study took place in 2022, with an order to the three teams on different sectors of the site. Operational follow-ups should follow.

European 14 :

- 1- Pantin: An "urban design study on the Portes de l'Ourcq sector" entrusted to each of the three selected teams. Study completed.
- 2- Besançon: In June 2018, the city of Besançon, Greater Besançon, the University of Franche-Comté, the CROUS and the TEMIS Technopole entered into an unprecedented partnership, by entrusting the Altitude 35 agency, the agent of a group, with the urban design and programming study of the Bouloie-Temis campus. Since then, the Altitude 35 team composed of Clara Loukkal and Benoît Barnoud (E14 winner with the Jurassic Park project) has been selected for the project management of the campus' outdoor spaces.
